

Test Way Sponsored Walk, Sunday 8th October 2017

Procedure for joining the 21st Romsey Scout Group Team

It's organised by Romsey Rotary Club and, if you follow the procedure below, 80% of the donations you raise will come to 21st Romsey Scout Group, 20% will go to the charitable work of the Rotary club.

To join our team follow the procedure below:

1. Create a JustGiving page to invite and receive donations:

- i. Go to the web-site above and click on the JustGiving purple disc on that page: This will take you to the JustGiving log-in page. If you are already registered with JustGiving enter your email address and password, otherwise click the "Sign up" option at the bottom of the box.
- ii. Follow the instructions on JustGiving to create a page for yourself – don't worry if it's not perfect, you can always edit it, add photos etc later. If you have followed the purple link from the Walk the Test way site this should have automatically associated the pages to show that you are raising money for "Rotary Club of Romsey Test Trust Fund" (the Rotary Club collect all the money and split it after the event).
- iii. Join yourself (your page) to the 21st Scout Group Test Way team by opening a new tab and going to www.justgiving.com/companyteams/21stromsey . This should link you automatically, otherwise click the "Join the Team" button on that page. Having done this you can exit from the JustGiving site.



2. Register with the Rotary Club that you are taking part

- i. Go to <http://walkthetestway.org.uk/register> and follow the instructions there. On the registration page you will be asked which charity you are raising money for – choose "21st Romsey (Nursling and Rownhams) Scout Group (302269)" from the drop-down menu. (302269 is our registered charity number).
- ii. Where it asks, enter that you are part of a group that is already registered and enter my walker number 31, as leader of the group. Note that you do not have to walk the same distance as I do. Where it asks, I am *not* responsible for collecting the money you raise (if raising through JustGiving I think this is irrelevant anyway; it only applies if using sponsor forms).
- iii. You will need to pay to enter I'm afraid – this is to cover the Rotary Club's costs in running the event. If you register before 31st May registration is free to under 16s; over 16s are £9 each. Note that children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult nominated by the child's family – it is not logistically possible for leaders of the Scout Group to be responsible for lots of children, walking different distances at different rates.
